TRINITY CHURCH FESTIVE FAIR takes place between 10am and 1pm on Saturday 14th November.

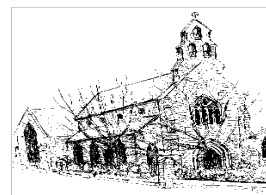
